



Timber Ridge School offers Individualized Student Alternative Education Plan (ISAEP) Program

To Be Considered For The ISAEP Program:

- ◇ Student must be 16-17 years of age.
- ◇ Parent and student must be fully informed about the program and consent to participation.
- ◇ Reading level at 7.5 grade level or better on the *Test of Adult Basic Education (TABE)*.
- ◇ Scores of 410 on each subtest of the GED Pre-Test.

ISAEP Program Description

1. Preparation for GED test:
 - ◇ McGraw Hill GED textbook is used. Pre and post tests following direct instruction indicates progression through each skill set.
2. Career and Technical Preparation:
 - ◇ *Virginia Wizard* and *Kuder*. Both curricula explore careers through assessment, aptitude, and provide guided career planning.
 - ◇ *R U Ready*. Curriculum guides students through discovery of a career path.
 - ◇ *Workplace Readiness certification* from the Commonwealth of Virginia Career Readiness Program

ISAEP Successful Completion

One of the following options must occur:

- ◇ *Workplace Readiness certification* from the Commonwealth of Virginia Career Readiness Program; or
- ◇ 120 hours of successful work experience; or
- ◇ Acceptance to an advanced technical training, higher education, or US armed forces.

GED Testing Protocol

1. Registration for test requires:
 - ◇ Government issued picture ID.
 - ◇ Social Security Card.
 - ◇ Payment of \$45 Registration Fee for VA students. If Pre-Test is taken and all subtests are passed, student earns a free voucher.
2. Criteria for passing:
 - ◇ Minimum of 410 on each of the 5 tests; and
 - ◇ An average score of 450 on the total battery.
