The *Transformation of Services Act* for at-risk youth of Virginia encourages the timely return of students from residential treatment to their families.

Transitional Day School allows for this timely transition while the student continues to attend academic classes on the Timber Ridge School campus.

Specific to geographical areas suitable for reasonable transportation.

Characteristics

- ◇ Family readiness to begin transition home.
- ◇ Student's behavior indicates a continued need for behavior support, clinical counseling, and individualized instruction.

Individualized Instruction

- ◇ General academics
- ◇ Special education
- ◇ Individualized Student Alternative Education Plan (ISAEP)
- ◇ Transitional and employment readiness

Specific Services

- ◇ Individual and group counseling.
- ◇ Family therapy and family support
- ◇ Behavior support
- ◇ Case management
- ◇ Academic skill development with low student/teacher ratios

Admission

Admission to Transitional Day School occurs through the Family Team meeting and is a step-down service within the Timber Ridge School program.
